

10 Days: Mt Kenya, Samburu, Borana and Aberdares

Description:

These Bush safari package allows you to explore Kenya's top wildlife reserves, from City tour to Coffee and Tea Tasting experience, Kenya's hidden gems in Laikipia, giving you unforgettable game drives and unique wildlife encounters. This package offers a mix of wildlife viewing, cultural experiences, bamboo forests, the highest waterfalls, and open moorlands.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi

- Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO). Our team will be on the ground for a meet and greet and will transfer you to your city accommodation.
- Relax and acclimatize, for a fresh start tomorrow.
- Dinner and overnight at Karen Blixen Cottages.

Day 2: Full day in Nairobi

- Enjoy an early breakfast, visit the **Giraffe Centre**, with an opportunity to feed and interact with endangered Rothschild giraffes while learning about their conservation.
- Start a journey to Kiambethu Tea Farm, which is approx. 1 hour drive, Arrive at **11am** and over a cup of tea or coffee the history of the farm and process of making tea is informally explained, followed by an opportunity to see tea in the field.
- Lunch is served about 1pm and is a three-course buffet lunch from our set menu prepared with vegetables from the garden, and desserts are topped with cream from our herd of Channel Island cows.
- Depart at precisely 2 pm for a 30-minute drive to Fairview Coffee Estate for a coffee tasting experience.
- Drive back to Nairobi for the evening, Dinner and overnight at Karen Blixen cottages.

Day 3: Nairobi to Nanyuki (Mt Kenya)

- Dawn is here, enjoy your last city breakfast, adventure awaits...
- Arrive right in time for a late lunch.

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- Enjoy an afternoon Horse ride and visit animal orphanage, sundowners at Ol Pejeta conservancy
- Bonfire and overnight at The River Camp

Day 4: Mt. Kenya

- Enjoy a bush breakfast by the river with morning views of Mt. Kenya, as your game drive awaits.
- Observe the world's fiercest predators in action.
- Enjoy your packed lunch under an Acacia tree as the wild action is just about to begin.
- You can enjoy a cold Tusker or a cold soft beverage of your choice on a bush sundowner (breathtaking experience)
- Overnight stay at The River Camp

Day 5: Mt Kenya to Samburu

- The dawn is here, breakfast is served by the foothill of a beautiful sunrise by the mountain, after breakfast, we have a two-hour drive to Samburu.
- Samburu National Reserve is unique for being home to the "Samburu Special Five" Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich, reticulated giraffe, gerenuk, and Beisa oryx, which are rare northern specialist species found only in this area of Kenya.
- Check in at Elephant Bedroom Camp in time for Lunch
- Enjoy an afternoon game drive, bush sundowners, bonfire, and overnight at Elephant Bedroom Camp

Day 6: Full Day at Samburu Conservancy

- Enjoy your breakfast overlooking the breathtaking landscapes with a sunrise.
- Several activities are planned for the day, including a visit to Buffalo Springs, Camel trekking, guided nature walks, Sundowners, a bonfire, and a Bush dinner.
- Overnight at Elephant Bedroom Camp.

Day 8: Samburu to the Kenyan Hidden Gem, (The Borana Conservancy)

 Breakfast is served, prepare to check out for a drive to Borana, approximately 1 hour's drive

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- Enjoy an afternoon game drive in Borana, one of the best conservancies in Kenya
- Borana holds the highest diversity of large mammal species of any ecosystem of its size in the world.
- Borana Conservancy is home to elephant, black rhino, lion, Jackson's hartebeest, reticulated giraffe, Grevy's zebra and many other endangered species
- Scenic views: Ewaso Ng'iro River, arid landscapes.
- Evening sundowners and bonfire, overnight stay at Borana Lodge.

Day 9: Full Day at Borana Conservancy

- Enjoy your breakfast overlooking the breathtaking landscapes with a sunrise.
- Several activities for the day, horse riding in the wild, Rhino tracking, a visit to Ngare Ndare Falls, and an afternoon game drive.
- Sundowner, bonfire and Bush dinner at Borana Lodge.

Day 7: Borana to Aberdares Conservancy

- Breakfast is served by the riverside, enjoy the wild experience as elephants come out by the river to quench their thirst
- Check out and kick off with the next face of the safari to the Aberdares
- Picturesque mountainous scenery, including the "Dragon's Teeth" volcanic rock formations. The Aberdares boast lush green lands, awe-striking waterfalls, and a cool, misty climate.
- Bonfire at Aberdares is a must for the chilly evenings, overnight at the Aberdares Country club.

Day 10: Aberdares to Nairobi

- Enjoy your last bush breakfast as we prepare to check out, approx. 4 hours' drive to Nairobi.
- A delicious Lunch at the Carnivore, sampling Kenyan open charcoal grill barbecue (*Brazilian style*), locally known as *nyama choma*, served with some traditional accompaniments/cuisines. What a way to bid Nairobi goodbye.
- The Afribay team is on standby to transfer you to the Airport in time for your flight home.

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
